Head Coach's Report - November 2025

North Devon Display Gymnastics Club

Competitively, the Club has enjoyed great success, with two out-of-county competitions resulting in strong performances, medals, and plenty of proud moments. Our development squads have been working hard, with new gymnasts successfully moving up from recreational classes – largely invited through impressive performances in our hugely popular and successful Club recreational competition. Their commitment and enthusiasm have been fantastic, and we're excited to see how they progress over the coming year. It's been wonderful to see the continued improvement in skill level and confidence across all age groups of our development squad.

The new Levels Award System introduced earlier this year has now been fully implemented. It's proving to be a really positive addition, giving gymnasts clear goals to work towards and recognition for their ongoing progress.

We've also introduced a Gymnasts' Code of Conduct, aimed at promoting positive behaviour, respect, and teamwork across all sessions. This has been implemented to ensure the gym remains a safe, encouraging, and enjoyable environment for everyone. Early feedback from coaches and gymnasts has been very positive, and we're already seeing improvements in focus, teamwork, and productivity in the gym.

A major highlight of the year was our Annual Awards and Presentation Show – a sell-out theatre event that celebrated our gymnasts' achievements and showcased their talent. The performance was outstanding, and it was fantastic to see so many families coming together to celebrate the Club's success.

Young Leaders Academy

The Young Leaders Academy continues to go from strength to strength. It's been great to see our young leaders gaining confidence, developing their coaching skills, and becoming an integral part of our sessions. They bring real energy and enthusiasm to the gym and serve as excellent role models for our younger gymnasts.

Our coaching team has remained stable this year, with very few changes – something that provides a great sense of continuity for our gymnasts. This consistency has allowed us to refine our coaching approach and ensure all sessions are of high quality, structured, and supportive.
